

Albion Community Council Meeting November 25, 2014, 4:00 p.m., Library

1. The meeting summary from September was approved with two changes. Attendance was added and the date of the next meeting was changed to November 20th.
2. Mr. Jensen provided training books to members of the SCC who did not attend training. He also noted that SCC membership rosters were turned into the district, fall reports were entered on the state website, council members viewed the 2 videos for SCC members, and the proposed meeting schedule and contact information of SCC members, and a summary of the implementation of the Land Trust Plan for the prior year is now posted on the school website.
3. Monica Carlson from the Counseling Office explained the Albion Explore Results. Math improved by 5%, Science improved by 21%, Reading fell by 6%. The science and reading benchmarks have changed. Mindy Timothy noted that science scores are improving because of a full year of science in 6th grade. 8th grade students are currently having their PCCR meetings with school counselors. An intern is currently working with the counselors, and she will be Cathy Nelson's long term sub when she goes out for maternity leave.
4. Mr. Jensen talked about the "Reunification Plan" that is being worked on with Sandy police. The police want a location where students could be moved in the case that the building becomes a crime scene. The church down the block on Newcastle is the most likely location. Will Powley will make contact and arrange a meeting with LDS church leaders about using the building.
5. Mr. Jensen showed a PowerPoint explaining the school's SAGE results. Albion was the high score in 4 of the 9 categories in the district. He explained that SAGE cannot be compared to the CRT tests and that the data from this test will be baseline data. Mr. Jameson noted that faculty is drilling down to specific areas that need improvement and will be working on those areas in the coming year. SAGE results will be mailed out to parents in the next 10 days.
6. SCC members expressed appreciation for positive postcards and Goblets of Goodness—part of Albion's PBIS program. They also appreciate the weekly update of activities, rather than a monthly newsletter. Skyward is currently being updated by teachers, so that parents and students will know upcoming tests, quizzes and major projects.
